AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to minors' consent to HIV/AIDS testing, treatment and prevention

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 2 2781-b to read as follows:

S 2781-B. ACCESS TO HIV/AIDS TESTING, PREVENTION AND TREATMENT FOR MINORS. A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER LICENSED, CERTIFIED OR OTHERWISE AUTHOR-5 IZED TO PRACTICE UNDER TITLE EIGHT OF THE EDUCATION LAW, ACTING WITHIN 6 HIS OR HER LAWFUL SCOPE OF PRACTICE, MAY, CONSISTENT WITH THIS ARTICLE, TEST, DIAGNOSE, REFER, TREAT AND PRESCRIBE FOR HIV INFECTION, HIV 8 RELATED ILLNESS, AND AIDS, INCLUDING PREVENTATIVE TREATMENT, AN INDIVID-9 UAL UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE WHO HAS THE CAPACITY TO CONSENT AND WHO

- 10 HAS BEEN, MAY HAVE BEEN, OR IS AT RISK OF BEING EXPOSED, TO HIV OR AIDS.
- 11 TESTING, DIAGNOSIS, REFERRAL, TREATMENT AND PRESCRIBING UNDER THIS
- 12 SECTION MAY BE PROVIDED WITHOUT THE CONSENT OR KNOWLEDGE OF THE PARENT 13 OR GUARDIAN OF THE INDIVIDUAL. HEALTH RECORDS AND OTHER INFORMATION
- 13 OR GUARDIAN OF THE INDIVIDUAL. HEALTH RECORDS AND OTHER INFORMATION 14 CONCERNING SUCH TESTING, DIAGNOSIS, REFERRAL, TREATMENT OR PRESCRIBING
- 15 SHALL BE CONFIDENTIAL HIV RELATED INFORMATION AND SHALL NOT BE DISCLOSED
- 16 EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN THIS ARTICLE.
- 17 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
