AN ACT to authorize the town of Brookhaven to extend the boundaries of the Setauket fire district to include the village of Old Field upon the abolition of the fire department of such village

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of article 11 of the town law to the contrary, upon the abolition of the fire department of the village of Old Field, in the county of Suffolk, the town board of the town of Brookhaven is authorized, in accordance with the provisions of subdivision 2 of section 170 of the town law, to extend the boundaries of the Setauket fire district to include the village of Old Field in its entirety for the purposes of providing fire protection and emergency response within such village.

S 2. Upon the extension by the town board of the town of Brookhaven of the Setauket fire district to include the village of Old Field, in accordance with section one of this act, such fire district and town board shall be subject to the provisions of article 11 of the town law, and shall continue to have all powers, duties and responsibilities vested in and imposed upon such districts and towns pursuant to such article, and the rules and regulations adopted pursuant thereto.

S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
