AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to prohibiting the reservation, making or facilitating of tee times on public golf courses in exchange for financial compensation

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 398-e to read as follows: 2
- S 398-E. PUBLIC GOLF COURSE TEE TIME RESERVATIONS. 1. NO PERSON, ORGANIZATION OR CORPORATION SHALL RESERVE, MAKE OR FACILITATE A TEE TIME ON A PUBLIC GOLF COURSE ON BEHALF OF ANOTHER PERSON OR PERSONS EXCHANGE FOR FINANCIAL COMPENSATION. ANY PERSON, ORGANIZATION OR CORPO-7 RATION VIOLATING THIS SECTION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF UP THOUSAND DOLLARS.
- 9 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION MAY BE ENFORCED CONCURRENTLY BY THE TOWN ATTORNEY, CITY CORPORATION COUNSEL, OR OTHER LAWFUL DESIGNEE 10 MUNICIPALITY OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT, AND ALL MONEYS COLLECTED THEREUNDER 11 SHALL BE RETAINED BY SUCH MUNICIPALITY OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT. 12
- 13 3. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO THE PAYMENT GREENS FEES, RENTAL CHARGES OR TIPS OF NOMINAL AMOUNTS. 14
- 15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
