Introduced by M. of A. WRIGHT -- read once and referred to the Committee on Housing

AN ACT to amend the public housing law, in relation to requiring that the New York city housing authority include a notice informing a prospective tenant or tenant of the ability to add legal occupants to the lease or renewal lease, and provide, upon request, a tenant with a form to add additional legal occupants

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivisions 7, 8 and 9 of section 402 of the public housing law, subdivision 8 as renumbered by chapter 467 of the laws of 1971, are renumbered subdivisions 8, 9 and 10 and a new subdivision 7 is added to read as follows:
- 5 7. A. THE NEW YORK CITY HOUSING AUTHORITY SHALL INCLUDE, ALONG WITH 6 EVERY LEASE OR RENEWAL LEASE OFFERED TO A PROSPECTIVE TENANT OR CURRENT 7 TENANT, A SEPARATE, CLEAR AND CONSPICUOUS NOTICE, INATLEAST SIXTEEN-POINT BOLDFACE TYPE, CONCERNING THE TENANT'S ABILITY TO ADD 8 9 ADDITIONAL LEGAL OCCUPANTS TO THE LEASE AGREEMENT.
- B. UPON RECEIPT OF A TENANT'S REQUEST FOR A FORM TO ADD AN ADDITIONAL LEGAL OCCUPANT, THE AUTHORITY SHALL, WITHIN SEVEN DAYS, PROVIDE THE TENANT WITH THE APPROPRIATE FORM, ALONG WITH A NOTICE INFORMING THE TENANT OF THE RIGHT TO CONTEST THE DENIAL OF ANY OCCUPANCY PERMISSION REQUEST.
- $\tilde{S}$  2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 16 have become a law.
