AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to establishing training and registration requirements for kidney dialysis patient care technicians

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new article 37-B to read as follows:

ARTICLE 37-B KIDNEY DIALYSIS PATIENT CARE TECHNICIANS

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3722. PRACTICE OF KIDNEY DIALYSIS PATIENT CARE.

3723. EXEMPTION.

S 3720. DEFINITIONS. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE:

1. "KIDNEY DIALYSIS PATIENT CARE TECHNICIAN" MEANS ANY PERSON, NOT 11 LICENSED TO PRACTICE MEDICINE OR NURSING, OR AS A PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT OR 12 13 SPECIALIST ASSISTANT, WHO PERFORMS KIDNEY DIALYSIS SERVICES ON A HUMAN TRAINING REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED 14 AND HAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THE PURSUANT TO SECTION THIRTY-SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE OF THIS ARTICLE AND 15 16 THE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT OF SECTION THIRTY-SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO 17 OF THIS ARTICLE.

2. "KIDNEY DIALYSIS PATIENT CARE TECHNICIAN TRAINEE" MEANS ANY PERSON,
 NOT LICENSED TO PRACTICE MEDICINE OR NURSING, OR AS A PHYSICIAN ASSIST ANT OR SPECIALIST ASSISTANT, WHO PERFORMS KIDNEY DIALYSIS SERVICES ON A
 HUMAN AND HAS ENROLLED IN OR COMPLETED THE TRAINING REQUIRED BY SECTION
 THIRTY-SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE OF THIS ARTICLE AND HAS NOT REGISTERED
 PURSUANT TO SECTION THIRTY-SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO OF THIS ARTICLE.

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3721. TRAINING. 1. THE COMMISSIONER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE 1 S 2 COMMISSIONER OF EDUCATION, SHALL ESTABLISH STANDARDIZED TRAINING 3 REQUIREMENTS FOR KIDNEY DIALYSIS PATIENT CARE TECHNICIANS.

4 2. SUCH TRAINING REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION AND 5 THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE COMMISSIONER SHALL HAVE CLEARLY DEFINED CRITERIA FOR EVALUATING, ON AN ANNUAL BASIS, EACH TRAIN-6 7 EE'S ATTAINMENT OF TRAINING GOALS AND COMPETENCY IN PROVISION OF KIDNEY 8 DIALYSIS SERVICES. KIDNEY DIALYSIS PATIENT CARE TECHNICIAN TRAINING 9 PROGRAMS MAY BE CONDUCTED BY:

(A) KIDNEY DIALYSIS PROVIDERS;

(B) DEGREE AND NON-DEGREE GRANTING INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION AS 11 12 DEFINED IN SECTION TWO OF THE EDUCATION LAW, CHARTERED, APPROVED OR LICENSED BY THE BOARD OF REGENTS; OR 13

14 (C) ANY OTHER ENTITY APPROVED BY THE COMMISSIONER TO CONDUCT SUCH A 15 PROGRAM.

16 3. THE TRAINING ESTABLISHED BY THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE 17 LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING TOPICS:

18 (A) AN OVERVIEW OF THE ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF KIDNEY DIALYSIS 19 PATIENT CARE TECHNICIANS; AND 20

(B) AN OVERVIEW OF KIDNEY DIALYSIS THERAPY.

21 S 3722. PRACTICE OF KIDNEY DIALYSIS PATIENT CARE. 1. EXCEPT AS OTHER-WISE PROVIDED BY THIS ARTICLE, NO PERSON SHALL PROVIDE KIDNEY DIALYSIS 22 SERVICES, AS SUCH SERVICES ARE DEFINED BY THE COMMISSIONER, UNLESS 23 SUCH 24 PERSON HAS COMPLETED THE TRAINING REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION 25 THIRTY-SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE OF THIS ARTICLE, AND HAS REGISTERED WITH 26 THE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION TWO OF THIS SECTION.

27 2. UPON THE SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE TRAINING REQUIRED PURSUANT TO 28 SECTION THIRTY-SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE OF THIS ARTICLE, A PERSON MAY 29 REGISTER WITH THE DEPARTMENT TO BECOME A KIDNEY DIALYSIS PATIENT CARE 30 TECHNICIAN.

3. A KIDNEY DIALYSIS PATIENT CARE TECHNICIAN AND A KIDNEY DIALYSIS 31 32 PATIENT CARE TECHNICIAN TRAINEE SHALL BE AUTHORIZED TO PERFORM SUCH PROCEDURES AND ACTIVITIES AS THE COMMISSIONER SHALL DEEM APPROPRIATE FOR 33 THE LEVEL OF TRAINING COMPLETED BY SUCH TECHNICIAN OR TRAINEE. 34

35 S 3723. EXEMPTION. THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION THIRTY-SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL NOT APPLY, UNTIL ONE YEAR AFTER THE 36 37 EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUCH SECTION, TO ANY PERSON WHO, ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE 38 OF SUCH SECTION, HAS BEEN PROVIDING KIDNEY DIALYSIS SERVICES FOR A PERI-39 OD OF NOT LESS THAN TWO YEARS.

40 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately; except that section 3722 of the public health law, as added by section one of this act, shall 41 take effect one year after the effective date of this act, and the 42 43 commissioner of health is immediately authorized and directed to promul-44 gate any rules and regulations necessary to implement the provisions of 45 such section 3722 on the effective date thereof.
