AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to allowing for the temporary transfer of a pistol between permit holders

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 400.04 to read as follows:
- S 400.04 TEMPORARY TRANSFER OF PISTOL BETWEEN PERMIT HOLDERS.
- 4 1. A PERMIT HOLDER, KNOWN IN THIS SECTION AS THE TRANSFEROR, MAY 5 TEMPORARILY TRANSFER POSSESSION OF PISTOLS TO ANOTHER PERMIT HOLDER, 6 KNOWN IN THIS SECTION AS THE TRANSFEREE, LICENSED IN THE SAME COUNTY FOR 7 A PERIOD NO LONGER THAN THIRTY DAYS. PRIOR TO A TRANSFER, THE PERMIT 8 HOLDER MUST FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE COUNTY CLERK IN THE COUNTY OF 9 ISSUANCE. THE COUNTY CLERK MAY COLLECT UP TO TEN DOLLARS FOR EACH APPLI-10 CATION, REGARDLESS OF THE NUMBER OF PISTOLS TRANSFERRED.
- 11 2. THE DIVISION OF STATE POLICE SHALL DEVELOP AN APPLICATION TO 12 COMPLETE SUCH TRANSFER. THE APPLICATION MUST BE NOTARIZED BY A LICENSED 13 NOTARY AND CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 14 (A) NAME, LICENSE NUMBER, ADDRESS AND PHONE NUMBER OF BOTH THE 15 TRANSFEROR AND TRANSFEREE;
- 16 (B) LIST OF PISTOLS AND THEIR SERIAL NUMBERS WHICH ARE BEING TEMPORAR-17 ILY TRANSFERRED FROM ONE PERMIT HOLDER TO THE OTHER PERMIT HOLDER;
 - (C) INDICATE THE REASON FOR TRANSFER;
 - (D) DATE OF PISTOL TRANSFER;

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- 20 (E) LENGTH OF TEMPORARY TRANSFER AND EXPECTED DAY OF RETURN FROM 21 TRANSFEREE TO TRANSFEROR.
- 3. THE APPLICATION SHALL INCLUDE A TRANSFER AGREEMENT STATEMENT THAT MUST BE SIGNED BY BOTH THE TRANSFEROR AND TRANSFEREE AND INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

EXPLANATION--Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [] is old law to be omitted.

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- (A) ALL TRANSFERRED PISTOLS SHALL AT ALL TIMES BE:
 - (I) KEPT ON THE PREMISE OF THE TRANSFEREE DURING THE TRANSFER PERIOD;
- (II) STORED IN A SAFE STORAGE DEPOSITORY AS DEFINED IN SECTION 265.45 OF THIS CHAPTER;
 - (III) UNLOADED AND SHALL NOT BE DISCHARGED.
 - (B) THE TRANSFEROR MUST COLLECT ALL TRANSFERRED PISTOLS BY THE DATE OF RETURN WHICH MAY NOT EXCEED THIRTY DAYS FROM THE DATE OF TRANSFER.
- 4. THE TRANSFEROR MUST FILE A STATEMENT OF RELINQUISHMENT WITH THE COUNTY CLERK NO MORE THAN FORTY-FIVE DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF TRANSFER.
- 10 5. THE COUNTY CLERK SHALL REPORT ANY DELINQUENT TRANSFERS, WHICH HAVE 11 NOT FILED A STATEMENT OF RELINQUISHMENT WITHIN FORTY-FIVE DAYS, TO THE 12 SHERIFF OF SUCH COUNTY. THE SHERIFF SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO SEIZE 13 THE UNRETURNED PISTOLS.
- 6. THE SHERIFF SHALL RETAIN THE PISTOLS PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION SIX OF SECTION 400.05 OF THIS ARTICLE AND MAY COLLECT A FEE OF UP TO TEN DOLLARS FOR EACH PISTOL UPON RETURN TO THE OWNER.
- 17 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-18 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
