AN ACT to grant Cole Samsel eligibility for permanent appointment as a police officer with the police department of the village of Oxford, in the county of Chenango

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of paragraph (a) of subdivisubdivision 4 of section 58 of the civil service law to the contrary, Cole Samsel, who previously received a permanent appointment in the competitive class of civil service as a police officer with the sheriff's department of the county of Chenango, resigned from such posi-5 6 tion after several years, has been absent from such position for more 7 than 30 days and is over the age of 35, shall be eligible for admission to the competitive examination for the position of deputy sheriff 8 offered in any county in the state and for provisional or permanent 9 10 appointment in the competitive class of the civil service as a police officer of the police department of the village of Oxford, in the county 11 of Chenango, if he shall, at the time of his appointment, be 40 years of 12 13 age or younger.

14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
