AN ACT to amend the real property law, in relation to entitling senior citizens to a refund of the portion of a security deposit exceeding one month's rent

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The real property law is amended by adding a new section 2 235-h to read as follows:

S 235-H. SENIOR CITIZENS SECURITY DEPOSIT REFUND. NO LANDLORD CHARGE MORE THAN THE EQUIVALENT OF ONE MONTH'S RENT AS A SECURITY DEPOS-FOR RESIDENTIAL RENTAL PREMISES OCCUPIED BY ANY TENANT WHO HAS ATTAINED THE AGE OF SIXTY-TWO YEARS OR OLDER AND WHO HAS OCCUPIED RENTAL FOR FIVE MORE YEARS. UPON ATTAINING RESIDENTIAL PREMISES OR SIXTY-TWO YEARS OF AGE DURING THE TERM OF OCCUPANCY, ANY TENANT NOTIFIES THE LANDLORD SHALL BE ENTITLED TO A REFUND OF THAT PORTION OF ANY SECURITY DEPOSIT HELD BY THE LANDLORD IN EXCESS OF ONE MONTH'S RENT. S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
