Introduced by M. of A. MOSLEY, GLICK, JAFFEE, ROBERTS, DUPREY, DINOWITZ, PAULIN, CAHILL, LIFTON -- Multi-Sponsored by -- M. of A. CROUCH, FAHY, GALEF -- read once and referred to the Committee on Higher Education

to amend the education law, in relation to the use and sale of tobacco at state-operated institutions of the state university of New York

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Legislative intent. The legislature finds and declares Section 1. it shall be the policy of the state university of New York (SUNY) to ensure that all state-operated campuses embrace a tobacco-free environment. Tobacco use is the number one preventable cause of death in the United States and accounts for more annual deaths than suicide, murder, 5 HIV/AIDS, alcohol use, illegal drug use and motor vehicle injuries 7 combined. Using tobacco is a personal choice, a tobacco-free policy does take away an individual's right to choose to use tobacco, it does 8 limit where a person may use tobacco. SUNY respects an individual's 9 10 right to choose to use tobacco off campus, in places where it is acceptable to do so. SUNY is first and foremost an educational institution. 11
- S 2. Section 355 of the education law is amended by adding a new subdivision 20 to read as follows: 12 13
- 20. THE FOLLOWING ARE PROHIBITED AT STATE-OPERATED INSTITUTIONS OF THE 14 15 STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK:
 - A. THE USE OR SALE OF TOBACCO ON ALL GROUNDS AND FACILITIES LEASED OR CONTROLLED BY THE STATE UNIVERSITY OR ITS RELATED ENTITIES, INCLUDING INDOOR AND OUTDOOR LOCATIONS; AND
- B. THE USE OF TOBACCO IN VEHICLES OWNED, RENTED OR LEASED BY THE STATE UNIVERSITY OR ITS AFFILIATED ENTITIES. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION, THE "AFFILIATED ENTITIES" OF THE STATE-OPERATED INSTITUTIONS 22 STATE UNIVERSITY ARE THE FOUNDATIONS, AUXILIARY SERVICES CORPORATIONS,
- 23 AND ALUMNI ASSOCIATIONS AND SUBSIDIARIES THEREOF.
