- AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to including employees of the office of children and family services on the list of public employees for which prevention of duties qualifies as assault in the second degree

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that 47 section two of this act shall take effect on the same date and in the 48 same manner as chapter 487 of the laws of 2015, takes effect; provided, 49 further, that section three of this act shall take effect on the same 50 date and in the same manner as chapter 472 of the laws of 2015, takes 51 effect.
