AN ACT to amend the town law, in relation to designating a board of registration for special town elections

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 84 of the town law, as amended by chapter 248 of the laws of 1963, is amended to read as follows:

- 3. In such event, the town board shall select from the list of election inspectors previously designated for general election purposes, not less than two nor more than four persons to constitute a board of registration for each voting place designated by the town board, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, A TOWN BOARD MAY, BY RESOLUTION ADOPTED AT A REGULAR MEETING, DETERMINE THAT ONE OR MORE BOARDS OF REGISTRATION SHALL BE REASONABLY CAPABLE OF CARRYING OUT THE PERSONAL REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS, AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, FOR ALL VOTING PLACES DESIGNATED for such special town election.
