AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to requiring the placement of countdown clocks alerting motorists of the duration of yellow lights in locations where red light cameras are operated; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1111-e to read as follows:

3 S 1111-E. YELLOW LIGHT COUNTDOWN CLOCK REQUIRED. ANY CITY OR COUNTY 4 OPERATING A DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM THAT IMPOSES MONETARY LIABILITY ON THE 5 OWNER OF THE VEHICLE FOR THE FAILURE OF AN OPERATOR THEREOF то COMPLY б WITH TRAFFIC-CONTROL INDICATIONS IN SUCH CITY OR COUNTY PURSUANT TO THIS 7 ARTICLE SHALL INSTALL AND MAINTAIN COUNTDOWN CLOCKS IN EACH DIRECTION OF EVERY INTERSECTION WHERE A TRAFFIC-CONTROL SIGNAL PHOTO VIOLATIONS-MONI-8 9 TORING DEVICE IS IN OPERATION. SUCH COUNTDOWN CLOCKS SHALL ALERT MOTOR-ISTS TO THE DURATION OF THE YELLOW LIGHT AT SUCH INTERSECTION, AND SHALL 10 11 BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE MANUAL AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR A UNIFORM SYSTEM OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AS PROVIDED IN SECTION SIXTEEN HUNDRED 12 PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE TERM 13 EIGHTY OF THIS CHAPTER. FOR THE 14 "TRAFFIC-CONTROL SIGNAL PHOTO VIOLATION-MONITORING DEVICE" SHALL MEAN А INSTALLED TO WORK IN CONJUNCTION WITH A TRAFFIC-CONTROL 15 VEHICLE SENSOR 16 SIGNAL WHICH AUTOMATICALLY PRODUCES TWO OR MORE PHOTOGRAPHS, TWO OR MORE MICROPHOTOGRAPHS, A VIDEOTAPE OR OTHER RECORDED IMAGES OF EACH VEHICLE 17 IT IS USED OR OPERATED IN VIOLATION OF SUBDIVISION (D) OF 18 AΤ THE TIME SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED ELEVEN OF THIS ARTICLE. 19

S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after it shall have become a law and shall expire December 1, 2015 when upon such date the provisions of this act shall be deemed repealed. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date is authorized to be made on or before such date.
