Introduced by M. of A. PEOPLES-STOKES -- read once and referred to the Committee on Transportation

AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to requiring one number plate on the rear of each motor vehicle

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 1 of section 402 of the vehi-2 cle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 109 of the laws of 2005, is 3 amended to read as follows:

4 (a) No person shall operate, drive or park a motor vehicle on the 5 public highways of this state unless such vehicle shall have a distinc-6 tive number assigned to it by the commissioner and a [set of] number 7 [plates] PLATE issued by the commissioner with a number and other iden-8 tification matter if any, corresponding to that of the certificate of 9 registration conspicuously displayed[, one] on the [front and one on the] rear of such vehicle, [each] EXCEPT IN CASE OF A TRACTOR WHEN 10 SUCH NUMBER PLATE SHALL BE DISPLAYED ON THE FRONT OF THE VEHICLE AND NONE 11 12 SHALL BE DISPLAYED ON ITS REAR, securely fastened so as to prevent the 13 same from swinging and placed, whenever reasonably possible, not higher 14 than forty-eight inches and not lower than twelve inches from the ground[; provided, however, that in any registration year for which only 15 16 number plate is issued, such number plate shall constitute a set of one 17 number plates for the time in which such use is authorized, shall be 18 displayed on the rear of the vehicle and none shall be displayed on its 19 front, except in case of a tractor, when such number plate shall be 20 displayed on the front of the vehicle and none shall be displayed on its 21 rear].

22 S 2. Subdivisions 2 and 3 of section 404-a of the vehicle and traffic 23 law, subdivision 2 as amended by chapter 191 of the laws of 1991 and 24 subdivision 3 as added by chapter 601 of the laws of 1987, are amended 25 to read as follows:

1 2. Registration of vehicles owned by severely disabled persons. The 2 commissioner shall assign to such motor vehicles, including any van or 3 pick-up truck used for transporting persons with disabilities which is 4 not used for commercial purposes, owned by such persons, a distinctive 5 number and issue and deliver in such manner as the commissioner may 6 select to the owner a certification of registration, in such form as the 7 commissioner shall prescribe and two number plates, called disabled 8 person plates. Said disabled person plates shall conform to the require-9 ments of section four hundred one of this [chapter] ARTICLE, but shall 10 bear distinctive marks to distinguish them from number plates to be 11 issued to other persons, qualifying under this chapter. [The commissioner, in his discretion, may issue, for any registration year, only one 12 plate as a set for a motor vehicle, in which event a set of disabled 13 14 person plates for a motor vehicle shall consist of one plate.] Where a 15 severely disabled person owns more than one vehicle and such vehicle or vehicles is or are used by severely disabled members of the owner's 16 17 family who reside with the owner, the commissioner shall issue one set plates for each additional vehicle used by such severely disabled 18 of 19 person, provided that such user qualifies as a severely disabled person 20 in the manner required by this section.

21 Registration of vehicles owned by severely disabled veterans. The 3. 22 commissioner shall assign to such motor vehicles, including any vans or pick-up trucks used for transporting handicapped veterans which are not 23 used for commercial purposes and which are owned by such veterans or a 24 25 not-for-profit corporation serving such veterans, a distinctive number and issue and deliver in such manner as the commissioner may prescribe 26 27 the owner a certification of registration, in such form as the to commissioner shall prescribe and two number plates, called disabled 28 29 veteran plates. Said severely disabled veteran plates shall conform to 30 the requirements of section four hundred one of this [chapter] ARTICLE, shall bear distinctive marks to distinguish them from number plates 31 but 32 to be issued to other persons, qualifying under this chapter. [The 33 commissioner in his discretion, may issue, for any registration year, only one plate as a set for a motor vehicle, in which event a set of 34 severely disabled veteran plates for a motor vehicle shall consist of 35 36 one plate.] Where a severely disabled veteran owns more than one vehicle 37 and such vehicle or vehicles is or are used by severely disabled members 38 of the owner's family who reside with the owner, the commissioner shall 39 issue one set of plates for each additional vehicle used by such severe-40 ly disabled veteran, provided that such user qualifies as a severely disabled veteran in the manner required by this section. For purposes of 41 42 this subdivision, the term "severely disabled veteran" shall mean any 43 member of the armed forces of the United States who served in time of 44 war, as defined in section eighty-five of the civil service law, and 45 whose disability qualifies him as a severely disabled person within the meaning of such term as defined in subdivision four of this section. 46

S 3. Subdivision 1 of section 404-j of the vehicle and traffic law, as separately amended by chapters 182 and 277 of the laws of 1991 and such section as renumbered by chapter 108 of the laws of 1994, is amended to read as follows:

1. Registration of vehicles owned by veterans who survived the Pearl Harbor attack. The commissioner shall assign to motor vehicles, owned by persons who while on military duty serving in the armed forces of the United States survived the Pearl Harbor attack by Japan on December seventh, nineteen hundred forty-one or the spouse of such a person, a distinctive number and issue and deliver in such manner as the commis-

sioner may select to the owner a certification of registration, in such 1 2 form as the commissioner shall prescribe and two number plates, called 3 Pearl Harbor attack veterans plates. Said plates shall conform to the 4 requirements of section four hundred one of this [chapter] ARTICLE, but 5 shall bear the distinctive words PEARL HARBOR SURVIVOR to distinguish 6 them from number plates to be issued to other persons, qualifying under 7 this chapter. [The commissioner, in his discretion, may issue, for any registration year, only one plate as a set for a motor vehicle, in which 8 event a set of plates for a motor vehicle shall consist of one plate.] 9 10 If a distinctive plate set is issued to a Pearl Harbor attack veteran section, such a distinctive plate set shall not be 11 pursuant to this issued to the spouse of such veteran. 12

S 4. Subdivision 4 of section 415 of the vehicle and traffic 13 law, as 14 amended by chapter 7 of the laws of 2000, is amended to read as follows: 15 4. Number plates. A dealer or other person, qualifying for limited use motor vehicles, motorcycles or trailers under subdivisions two and 16 of three of this section, shall be entitled to receive one or more sets of 17 number plates for display thereon as the commissioner may determine, 18 upon payment of the required fee for each set. Number plates issued to 19 20 dealers under this section shall bear distinctive marks to distinguish 21 them from transporter plates to be issued to other persons qualifying 22 under this section. [A set of number plates shall consist of two plates 23 in the case of a motor vehicle and one plate in the case of a motorcycle 24 or trailer; provided, however, that the commissioner, in his discretion, 25 may issue, for any registration year, only one number as a set for a 26 motor vehicle, in which event a set of number plates for a motor vehicle 27 shall consist of one plate.]

28 S 5. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new section 29 131-b to read as follows:

30 S 131-B. SET OF NUMBER PLATES OR TWO NUMBER PLATES. SET OF NUMBER 31 PLATES OR TWO NUMBER PLATES MEANS ONE NUMBER PLATE PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH 32 (A) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION FOUR HUNDRED TWO OF THIS CHAPTER.

33 S 6. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 34 it shall have become a law; provided that the commissioner of motor 35 vehicles is authorized and directed to promulgate, amend and/or repeal 36 any rules and regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this 37 act on its effective date on or before such date.
