- AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to long range financial planning for school districts

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 3817 2 to read as follows:

3 S 3817. LONG RANGE FINANCIAL PLAN. 1. EACH YEAR, COMMENCING WITH THE 4 TWO THOUSAND SIXTEEN--TWO THOUSAND SEVENTEEN PROPOSED BUDGET FOR THE 5 SCHOOL YEAR, THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER OF EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT, IN 6 CONSULTATION WITH THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND THE AUDIT COMMITTEE, PROVIDED SUCH COMMITTEE EXISTS, SHALL PREPARE FOR APPROVAL BY THE BOARD 7 8 TRUSTEES A LONG RANGE FINANCIAL PLAN TO ASSIST DISTRICTS IN ESTAB-OF 9 LISHING AND PLANNING FINANCIAL GOALS AND PROJECTIONS.

2. THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER MAY INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, THE 10 ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT FOR BUSINESS, SCHOOL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR, 11 SCHOOL BUSINESS OFFICER, OR OTHER SIMILAR OFFICIAL THAT REPORTS DIRECTLY 12 13 TΟ THE SUPERINTENDENT AND HOLDS THE APPROPRIATE CERTIFICATION AS REQUIRED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR A SCHOOL DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR, 14 SCHOOL 15 BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR, OR SCHOOL DISTRICT BUSINESS LEADER, OR OTHER PERSON HOLDING AN APPROPRIATE CERTIFICATE AS DETERMINED BY 16 THE DEPART-17 MENT.

A LONG RANGE FINANCIAL PLAN SHALL MEAN A PLAN THAT INCLUDES INFOR MATION FOR THE CURRENT SCHOOL YEAR AND PROJECTIONS FOR AT LEAST THE
 SUBSEQUENT TWO YEARS OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT COVERS: (A) REVENUES;
 (B) EXPENDITURES; (C) UNASSIGNED FUND BALANCE; (D) RESTRICTED FUND

4. A SCHOOL DISTRICT MUST POST ON ITS WEBSITE, IF AVAILABLE, AND IN
FIVE PUBLIC PLACES IN SAID DISTRICT, THE DISTRICT'S LONG RANGE FINANCIAL
PLAN, ANNUAL AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENT, INCLUDING ANY CORRECTIVE
ACTION PLAN AS REQUIRED BY SECTION TWENTY-ONE HUNDRED SIXTEEN-A OF THIS
CHAPTER, AND ADOPTED ANNUAL BUDGET.

8 5. A DISTRICT MAY APPLY TO THE COMMISSIONER FOR A WAIVER OF THE 9 REQUIREMENT TO PREPARE A LONG TERM FINANCIAL PLAN UNDER SUBDIVISION ONE 10 OF THIS SECTION, WHICH MAY BE GRANTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMIS-11 SIONER IF THE COMMISSIONER DEEMS THAT COMPLIANCE WITH SUCH SUBDIVISION 12 WOULD BE UNDULY BURDENSOME OR IMPRACTICABLE FOR THE SCHOOL DISTRICT.

13 S 2. This act shall take effect one year after it shall have become a 14 law.
