AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to authorizing distinctive license plates for recipients of the Bronze or Silver star

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new section 404-x to read as follows:

3 404-X. DISTINCTIVE PLATES FOR BRONZE OR SILVER STAR RECIPIENTS. 1. S 4 ANY RECIPIENT OF A BRONZE STAR OR A SILVER STAR RESIDING IN THIS STATE 5 ANY SUCH RECIPIENT SHALL, UPON REQUEST, BE ISSUED A THE SPOUSE OF OR 6 LICENSE PLATE BEARING THE WORDS "BRONZE STAR RECIPIENT" OR "SILVER STAR 7 RECIPIENT". IF A DISTINCTIVE PLATE IS ISSUED TO A BRONZE OR SILVER STAR 8 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION, SUCH A DISTINCTIVE PLATE SHALL NOT RECIPIENT 9 BE ISSUED TO THE SPOUSE OF SUCH RECIPIENT. APPLICATION FOR SAID LICENSE FILED WITH THE COMMISSIONER IN SUCH FORM AND DETAIL AS 10 SHALL BE PLATE THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PRESCRIBE. 11

12 2. THE DISTINCTIVE PLATE AUTHORIZED HEREIN SHALL BE ISSUED UPON PROOF, 13 SATISFACTORY TO THE COMMISSIONER, THAT THE APPLICANT OR THE SPOUSE OF 14 THE APPLICANT IS A BRONZE OR SILVER STAR RECIPIENT.

3. A DISTINCTIVE PLATE ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE ISSUED 15 SAME MANNER AS OTHER NUMBER PLATES UPON PAYMENT OF THE REGULAR 16 INTHE17 REGISTRATION FEE PRESCRIBED BY SECTION FOUR HUNDRED ONE OF THIS ARTICLE, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT AN ADDITIONAL ONE-TIME 18 SERVICE CHARGE OF TEN 19 DOLLARS SHALL BE CHARGED FOR SUCH PLATE. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT ONE YEAR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION, FUNDS IN 20 THEAMOUNT OF THOUSAND DOLLARS, OR SO MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE AVAILABLE, SHALL BE 21 FIVE 22 DEPARTMENT TO OFFSET COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH ALLOCATED TO THE THE 23 PRODUCTION OF SUCH LICENSE PLATES.

24 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 25 it shall have become a law.
