AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to requiring cash lanes to be made available at certain toll barriers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

The public authorities law is amended by adding a new Section 1. section 1266-k to read as follows:

- 3 1266-K. PLACEMENT OF ELECTRONIC TOLL COLLECTION SYSTEM LANES AT METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY TOLL BARRIERS LOCATED HAVING A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE. THE CHAIRMAN OF THE AUTHORITY SHALL ESTABLISH, BY RULE OR REGULATION, REQUIREMENTS CASH LANE TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE 7 OF AT LEAST ONE PLACEMENT 8 COLLECTION OF TOLLS AND FARES WHERE ELECTRONIC TOLL COLLECTION 9 DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION TWELVE OF SECTION TWENTY-NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE OF THIS CHAPTER, HAVE BEEN DESIGNATED AT THE TOLL BARRIERS OPERATED 10 BY THE METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY AT A TOLL HIGHWAY, 11 TUNNEL OR OTHER THOROUGHFARE LOCATED WITHIN A CITY HAVING A POPULATION 12 OF ONE MILLION OR MORE. SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL 13 SPECIFY 14 GENERAL LOCATION OF THE ROADWAY LANES IN WHICH CASH LANES SHALL BE 15 LOCATED.
- S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 16 17 it shall have become a law, provided, however, that the chairman of metropolitan transportation authority is authorized and directed to 18 promulgate any rules and regulations necessary to implement 19 provisions of this act on or before such effective date. 20
