LAVALLE -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Local Government -- recommitted to the Committee on Local Government in accordance with Senate Rule 6, sec. 8 -- reported favorably from said committee, ordered to first and second report, ordered to a third reading, passed by Senate and delivered to the Assembly, recalled, vote reconsidered, restored to third reading, amended and ordered reprinted, retaining its place in the order of third reading -- again amended and ordered reprinted, retaining its place in the order of third reading

IN ASSEMBLY -- Introduced by M. of A. THIELE -- read once and referred to the Committee on Transportation -- recommitted to the Committee on Transportation in accordance with Assembly Rule 3, sec. 2 -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee -- again reported from said committee with amendments, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee

AN ACT authorizing the villages of East Hampton and Sag Harbor to reduce the maximum speed limit along certain designated streets in such villages to not less than 20 miles per hour

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any general, special or local law or code
2 to the contrary, the village board of the village of East Hampton in
3 Suffolk county, subject to the limitations imposed by sections 1624 and
4 1684 of the vehicle and traffic law, may by local law, ordinance, order,
5 rule or regulation establish maximum speed limits at not less than twenty
6 miles per hour on any portion of the following streets within such
7 village: King Street, McGuirk Street, Middle Lane, Mill Hill Lane and
8 Meadow Way.
9 S 2. Notwithstanding any general, special or local law or code to the
10 contrary, the village board of the village of Sag Harbor in Suffolk
