AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring alternative power sources for motor fuel facilities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 396-bbb to read as follows:

3 S 396-BBB. ALTERNATIVE POWER SOURCES FOR MOTOR FUEL FACILITIES. 1. 4 FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION:

5 "ALTERNATIVE POWER SOURCE" MEANS A SOURCE OF ELECTRICAL POWER (A) OTHER THAN A SOURCE THAT REQUIRES INTERCONNECTION TO THE FACILITIES OF 6 AN ELECTRIC CORPORATION, AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION THIRTEEN OF SECTION 7 TWO OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE LAW, THAT IS: (I) CAPABLE OF PROVIDING ELEC-8 TRICAL POWER FOR THE OPERATION OF ALL FUEL PUMPS AND ANY OTHER POWER 9 10 LOADS NECESSARY FOR THE DISPENSING AND SALE OF MOTOR FUEL CONTINUOUSLY FOR A MINIMUM OF SEVENTY-TWO HOURS; AND (II) GENERATED BY SOLAR OR WIND 11 POWER, OR FUEL THAT HAS A SULFUR CONTENT OF NO MORE THAN FIFTEEN PARTS 12 13 PER MILLION.

14 (B) "MOTOR FUEL" MEANS ANY PETROLEUM PRODUCT USED FOR THE PROPULSION 15 OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLE.

(C) "MOTOR FUEL FACILITY" MEANS A FACILITY THAT IS USED FOR THE 16 17 PURPOSE OF OFFERING MOTOR FUEL FOR SALE AT RETAIL TO THE PUBLIC OR FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING, STORING, HANDLING, OR TRANSFERRING MOTOR FUEL. 18 (D) "TRANSFER SWITCH" MEANS A QUICK CONNECT OR A SWITCHBOARD DESIGNED 19 TO ALLOW CONNECTION OF A MOBILE GENERATOR, OR OTHER ALTERNATIVE POWER 20 21 SOURCE, TO A MOTOR FUEL FACILITY, AS DEFINED AND REQUIRED ΒY THIS 22 SECTION.

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3 TEEN OF SECTION TWO OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE LAW, TO A MOTOR FUEL FACILITY.
4 2. EVERY NEWLY CONSTRUCTED OR SUBSTANTIALLY RENOVATED MOTOR FUEL
5 FACILITY GIVEN A CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY ON OR AFTER JANUARY FIRST, TWO
6 THOUSAND SIXTEEN SHALL HAVE INSTALLED IN SUCH FACILITY AN APPROPRIATE
7 TRANSFER SWITCH AND ALL OTHER ELECTRICAL WIRING NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE
8 THE TRANSFER OF POWER TO AN ALTERNATIVE POWER SOURCE.

9 3. THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE TRANSFER SWITCH AND ALL 10 OTHER ELECTRICAL WORK NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE TRANSFER OF POWER TO 11 AN ALTERNATIVE POWER SOURCE, AS REQUIRED BY SUBDIVISION TWO OF THIS 12 SECTION, AND THE ALTERNATIVE POWER SOURCE, AS REQUIRED BY SUBDIVISION 13 FOUR OF THIS SECTION, SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL APPLICABLE LAWS AND REGU-14 LATIONS, INCLUDING LOCAL CONSTRUCTION AND FIRE CODES.

4. EACH NEWLY CONSTRUCTED OR SUBSTANTIALLY RENOVATED MOTOR FUEL FACILITY GIVEN A CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY ISSUED ON OR AFTER JANUARY FIRST,
TWO THOUSAND SIXTEEN SHALL BE CAPABLE OF OPERATING ALL FUEL PUMPS,
DISPENSING EQUIPMENT, LIFE SAFETY SYSTEMS AND PAYMENT ACCEPTANCE EQUIPMENT USING AN ALTERNATIVE GENERATED POWER SOURCE WITHIN TWENTY-FOUR
HOURS OF A POWER INTERRUPTION.

5. EACH PERSON WHO OWNS, LEASES, OPERATES OR OTHERWISE MANAGES OR CONTROLS A MOTOR FUEL FACILITY SHALL MAINTAIN AT SUCH FACILITY DOCUMEN-TATION OF THE INSTALLATION REQUIRED BY SUBDIVISION TWO OF THIS SECTION, AS WELL AS ANY PERIODIC TESTING NECESSARY TO ENSURE THE OPERATIONAL CAPABILITY OF SUCH INSTALLATION. SUCH DOCUMENTATION SHALL BE MADE AVAIL-ABLE UPON REQUEST.

6. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL PRECLUDE THE APPLICATION OF LOCAL
LAWS AND REGULATIONS, NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THIS SECTION, GOVERNING THE
INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE AND INSPECTION OF, AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS
RELATING TO, ALTERNATIVE POWER SOURCES.

31 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
