- AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to requiring agencies to provide potential adoptive parents with information concerning state-funded benefits or services received by a foster child that expire upon adoption

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 372-f of the social services law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:

3 5. THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES SHALL PROMULGATE REGU-LATIONS WHICH SHALL REQUIRE AUTHORIZED AGENCIES IN THE STATE TO PROVIDE 4 5 A FOSTER PARENT, WHO HAS EXPRESSED INTEREST IN ADOPTING A FOSTER CHILD, 6 WITH A LIST OF ANY PUBLICLY-FUNDED BENEFITS OR SERVICES THAT SUCH FOSTER 7 BE ELIGIBLE FOR UPON THE ADOPTION OF SUCH FOSTER CHILD AS CHILD WILL 8 WELL AS A LIST OF ANY PUBLICLY-FUNDED BENEFITS OR SERVICES THAT SUCH 9 IS CURRENTLY ELIGIBLE SHALL EXPIRE UPON THE FOSTER CHILD FOR, BUT 10 ADOPTION OF SUCH FOSTER CHILD. IF A SERVICE SHALL EXPIRE, INFORMATION SHALL BE PROVIDED ON IF THAT SERVICE IS AVAILABLE IN THE COMMUNITY OR 11 HOW THAT SERVICE CAN BE OBTAINED FROM OTHER PRIVATE 12 SOURCES. SUCH 13 INFORMATION SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC ON SUCH OFFICE'S 14 WEBSITE.

15 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 16 have become a law.
