AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to deeming assault on a station customer assistant, maintainer, cleaner or janitor while in performance of their assigned duties to be assault in the second degree

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 11 of section 120.05 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 196 of the laws of 2014, is amended to read as follows:

With intent to cause physical injury to a train operator, inspector, conductor, signalperson, bus operator [or], station agent, STATION CUSTOMER ASSISTANT, ANY PERSON WHOSE OFFICIAL DUTIES INCLUDE THE SALE OF TICKETS, PASSES, VOUCHERS OR OTHER PAYMENT OF FARE TRAIN OR BUS, ANY PERSON WHOSE OFFICIAL DUTIES INCLUDE THE MAINTENANCE OR OPERATION OF A TRAIN OR BUS STATION OR TERMINAL employed by any transit agency, authority or company, public or private, whose operation is authorized by New York state or any of its political subdivisions, a city marshal, a school crossing quard appointed pursuant to section two hundred eight-a of the general municipal law, a traffic enforcement officer, traffic enforcement agent, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, sanitation enforcement agent, New York city sanitation worker, registered nurse or licensed practical nurse he or she causes physical injury to such operator, ticket inspector, conductor, signalperson, bus operator [or], station agent, STATION CUSTOMER ASSISTANT, ANY PERSON WHOSE OFFICIAL DUTIES INCLUDE THE SALE OF TICKETS, PASSES, VOUCHERS OR OTHER PAYMENT OF FARE TO USE A TRAIN OR BUS, ANY PERSON WHOSE OFFICIAL DUTIES INCLUDE THE MAINTENANCE OR OPERATION OF A TRAIN OR BUS STATION OR TERMINAL city
