AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to removing any imposed confidentiality agreements regarding common core testing

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 305 of the education law is amended by adding a new subdivision 53 to read as follows:
 - 53. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL:

- A. RELEASE COMMON CORE TEST CONTENT, QUESTIONS, AND ANSWERS FOR PUBLIC 5 REVIEW AND DISCUSSION POST-TEST;
 - B. AMEND AND/OR REMOVE PROVISIONS OF THE EXISTING COMMON CORE AGREEMENT OR ANY SUCH FUTURE AGREEMENTS REQUIRED BY THE DENTIALITY DEPARTMENT, ITS VENDORS AND/OR SCHOOL DISTRICTS, THAT PROHIBIT TEACHERS, ADMINISTRATORS, OR OTHER SCHOOL EMPLOYEES FROM:
 - (1) DISCLOSING TEST CONTENT, QUESTIONS OR ANSWERS; AND
- (2) DISCLOSING OR RETAINING ANY NOTES PERSONALLY TAKEN OR PREPARED AT 11 THE TIME OF THE EXAMINATION; 12
- C. ENSURE THAT TEACHERS, ADMINISTRATORS, OR OTHER SCHOOL EMPLOYEES WHO 14 CHOOSE AFTER COMPLETION OF THEEXAMINATION TO ENGAGE INDISCUSSION OF COMMON CORE TEST CONTENT NOT BE SUBJECT TO:
- (1) ANY DISCIPLINARY ACTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS THREE THOUSAND 16 17 TWENTY AND THREE THOUSAND TWENTY-A OF THIS CHAPTER; AND/OR
- (2) ANY ACTION AGAINST THEIR CERTIFICATION 18 **PURSUANT** TO PART 19 EIGHTY-THREE OF THE REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSIONER; AND
- PROHIBIT THE REOUIREMENT THAT TEACHERS, ADMINISTRATORS, OR OTHER 20 SCHOOL EMPLOYEES SIGN A COMMON CORE CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT. 21
- S 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 22
