AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to permitting persons with a criminal record to volunteer and provide counseling and programming services within the prison system in certain circumstances

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The correction law is amended by adding a new section 624 2 to read as follows:
- to read as follows:
  S S 624. VOLUNTEERS FOR PRISON COUNSELING AND PROGRAMMING; ELIGIBILITY.
- 4 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, A PERSON
- 5 WITH A CRIMINAL RECORD WHO HAS DEMONSTRATED A STEADFAST COMMITMENT TO
- 6 HIS OR HER COMMUNITY AND WHO HAS HAD NO FURTHER INVOLVEMENT OF A CRIMI-
- 7 NAL NATURE SINCE HIS OR HER LAST CONVICTION FOR TWENTY YEARS OR LONGER,
- 8 SHALL BE PERMITTED TO VOLUNTEER AND PROVIDE COUNSELING AND PROGRAMMING
- 9 SERVICES TO PRISONERS IF SUCH PERSON MEETS ALL OTHER CRITERIA SET FORTH 10 BY THE COMMISSIONER.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
