AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to discrimination against volunteer drivers in the issuance of motor vehicle liability insurance coverage

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The insurance law is amended by adding a new section 2335-b to read as follows:

S 2335-B. DISCRIMINATION AGAINST VOLUNTEER DRIVERS. NO INSURER AUTHOR-IZED TO TRANSACT OR TRANSACTING BUSINESS IN THIS STATE, OR CONTROLLING OR CONTROLLED BY OR UNDER COMMON CONTROL BY OR WITH AN INSURER AUTHOR-IZED TO TRANSACT OR TRANSACTING BUSINESS IN THIS STATE, WHICH SELLS POLICIES PROVIDING MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE IN THIS STATE SHALL REFUSE TO PROVIDE SUCH A POLICY OR INCREASE THE POLICY PREMIUM IN CONNECTION WITH THE INSURANCE PERMITTED OR REQUIRED BY THIS CHAPTER SOLELY BECAUSE THE INSURED OR ANY OTHER PERSON WHO CUSTOMARILY

11 OPERATES AN AUTOMOBILE COVERED BY THE POLICY IS A VOLUNTEER DRIVER. FOR 12 THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "VOLUNTEER DRIVER" MEANS A PERSON WHO

13 PROVIDES SERVICES, INCLUDING TRANSPORTING INDIVIDUALS OR GOODS, WITHOUT

13 PROVIDES SERVICES, INCLUDING TRANSPORTING INDIVIDUALS OR GOODS, WITHOUT 14 COMPENSATION ABOVE EXPENSES TO A NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION OR CHARITA-
