AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to discrimination against volunteer drivers in the issuance of motor vehicle liability insurance coverage

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The insurance law is amended by adding a new section 2335-b 2 to read as follows:

3 S 2335-B. DISCRIMINATION AGAINST VOLUNTEER DRIVERS. NO INSURER AUTHOR-TO TRANSACT OR TRANSACTING BUSINESS IN THIS STATE, OR CONTROLLING 4 IZED 5 OR CONTROLLED BY OR UNDER COMMON CONTROL BY OR WITH AN INSURER AUTHOR-TRANSACT OR TRANSACTING BUSINESS IN THIS STATE, WHICH SELLS б IZED TO 7 POLICIES PROVIDING MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE ΙN THIS 8 STATE SHALL REFUSE TO PROVIDE SUCH A POLICY OR INCREASE THE POLICY PREMIUM IN CONNECTION WITH THE INSURANCE PERMITTED OR REQUIRED 9 ΒY THIS CHAPTER SOLELY BECAUSE THE INSURED OR ANY OTHER PERSON WHO CUSTOMARILY 10 OPERATES AN AUTOMOBILE COVERED BY THE POLICY IS A VOLUNTEER DRIVER. 11 FOR "VOLUNTEER DRIVER" MEANS A PERSON WHO SECTION, 12 THE PURPOSES OF THIS 13 PROVIDES SERVICES, INCLUDING TRANSPORTING INDIVIDUALS OR GOODS, WITHOUT COMPENSATION ABOVE EXPENSES TO A NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION OR CHARITA-14 15 BLE ORGANIZATION.

16 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
