AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to sentencing

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 60.02 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 471 of the laws of 1980, is amended to read as follows:

- (2) If the sentence is to be imposed upon a youthful offender finding which has been substituted for a conviction for any felony, the court must impose a sentence authorized to be imposed upon a person convicted of a class E felony [provided, however, that the court must not impose a sentence of conditional discharge or unconditional discharge if the youthful offender finding was substituted for a conviction of a felony defined in article two hundred twenty of this chapter], AS HEREINAFTER PROVIDED:
- IF THE YOUTHFUL OFFENDER FINDING WAS SUBSTITUTED FOR A CONVICTION OF A FELONY DEFINED IN ARTICLE TWO HUNDRED TWENTY OR TWO HUNDRED TWEN-THIS CHAPTER, THEN THE SENTENCE SHALL BE AS AUTHORIZED BY TY-ONE OF SECTION 60.04 OF THIS ARTICLE FOR A CLASS E FELONY, AND IF A DETERMINATE SENTENCE OF IMPRISONMENT IS IMPOSED, THE CORRESPONDING PERIOD OF POST-RELEASE SUPERVISION PROVIDED FOR THAT CLASS E FELONY BY SECTION 70.45 OF THIS TITLE SHALL ALSO BE IMPOSED.
- 18 (B) IF THE YOUTHFUL OFFENDER FINDING WAS SUBSTITUTED FOR A CONVICTION 19 OF ANY OTHER FELONY, THEN THE SENTENCE SHALL BE AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 20 60.01 OF THIS ARTICLE FOR A SENTENCE UPON A CONVICTION OF A CLASS E FELONY OFFENSE; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT IF THE YOUTHFUL OFFENDER FINDING 21 WAS SUBSTITUTED FOR A CONVICTION OF A VIOLENT FELONY OFFENSE AS 22 DEFINED 70.02 OF THIS TITLE OR A FELONY SEX OFFENSE AS DEFINED IN 23 SECTION 24 PARAGRAPH (A) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION 70.80 OF THIS TITLE 25 SENTENCE OF IMPRISONMENT IN EXCESS OF ONE YEAR IS IMPOSED TO BE SERVED 26 IN A FACILITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND STATE
