AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to requiring notifications to insured persons that an out-of-network physician or specialist may be used in their procedure, test or surgery

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The insurance law is amended by adding a new section 3242 to read as follows:
  - S 3242. NOTICE OF OUT-OF-NETWORK PHYSICIAN OR SPECIALIST. EVERY PERSON INSURED UNDER A POLICY OF ACCIDENT AND HEALTH INSURANCE DELIVERED
- 5 OR ISSUED FOR DELIVERY SHALL BE ENTITLED TO NOTIFICATION PRIOR TO THEIR
- 6 PROCEDURE, TEST OR SURGERY FROM THE PHYSICIAN OR SPECIALIST WHO MAY BE
- 7 USED IN SUCH PROCEDURE, TEST OR SURGERY THAT SUCH PHYSICIAN'S OR 8 SPECIALIST'S SERVICES SHALL NOT BE COVERED BY THEIR INSURANCE POLICY.
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
