AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to the real property tax exemption for persons with disabilities and limited incomes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

The closing paragraph of subdivision 2 of section 459-c of Section 1. the real property tax law, as amended by chapter 265 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read as follows:

An award letter from the Social Security Administration or the Railroad Retirement Board, or a certificate from the state commission for the blind, or an award letter from the United States Postal Service, or an award letter from the United States department of veterans affairs shall be submitted as proof of disability. IF A PERSON IS UNABLE AWARD LETTER FROM THE SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION DUE TO INSUFFICIENT WORK CREDITS TO OUALIFY FOR SSDI, A DENIAL OR DISAPPROVAL LETTER OR NOTICE OF DISAPPROVED CLAIM FROM THE SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINIS-TRATION TOGETHER WITH A MEDICAL CERTIFICATION OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S QUALI-FYING DISABILITY PREPARED BY A DULY LICENSED PHYSICIAN AND CERTIFICATION OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S QUALIFYING DISABILITY PREPARED BY THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION BOARD SHALL BE DEEMED SUFFICIENT INLIEU OF SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION. AWARD LETTER FROM THE SUCH MEDICAL
