AN ACT in relation to a certain agreement for a payment in lieu of taxes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (e) of section 15 of the tax law, with respect to any payment of taxes imposed on real property with respect to property located at 85 Saxon Avenue, Bay Shore, New York, with respect to a lessee that is a qualified empire zone enterprise, such taxes shall be deemed to be eligible real property 5 taxes with respect to such lessee and (1) such taxes shall be deemed to have been paid by the lessee pursuant to explicit requirements in a written lease, (2) shall be deemed to become a lien on the real property 8 9 during a taxable year in which the lessee of the real property is both certified pursuant to article 18-B of the general municipal law and a 10 qualified empire zone enterprise, and (3) the lessee shall be deemed to 11 have made direct payment of such taxes to the taxing authority and to 12 13 have received a receipt for such payment of taxes from the taxing 14 Such qualified empire zone enterprise shall be eligible to 15 claim the real property tax credit provided by section 15 of the tax law provided that for each of such periods, the landlord has not filed a 16 17 claim for the real property tax credit for such payments.

S 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 687 or 1087 of the tax law or any other provision to the contrary, a claim for a credit or refund may be filed by the taxpayer with respect to the property located at 85 Saxon Avenue, Bay Shore, New York, for taxable years January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2011 where the taxpayer is a qualified empire zone enterprise.
