AN ACT in relation to permitting the Gobind Marg Charitable Society, Incorporated to file an application for certain real property tax exemptions

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the assessor of the county of Nassau is hereby authorized to accept from the Gobind Marg Charitable Society, Incorporated, an application for exemptions from real property taxes pursuant to section 420-a of the real property tax law for part of the 2012-2013 assessment roll, the 6 2013-2014 assessment roll, and the 2014-2015 assessment roll for 7 parcel owned by such not-for-profit corporation which is located at 383 8 Jericho Turnpike, village of New Hyde Park, town of North Hempstead, 9 county of Nassau, otherwise known as Nassau county tax map section 8, block 77, lots 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30 and 74, and 10 section 32, block 83, lot 88. If accepted, the applications shall be 11 reviewed as if they had been received on or before the taxable status 12 date established for such rolls. If satisfied that such not-for-profit 13 organization would otherwise be entitled to such exemptions if such 14 not-for-profit organization had filed applications for exemptions by the 15 16 appropriate taxable status dates, the assessor, upon approval by the 17 Nassau county legislature may make appropriate correction to the subject 18 rolls. If such exemptions are granted and such organization, therefore, 19 shall have paid any taxes with respect to the subject rolls, the applicable governing body or tax department may, in its sole discretion, 20 provide for the refund of those taxes paid and cancel those taxes, fines, penalties, liens, or interest remaining unpaid. 21 22
