AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to requiring the development of a program addressing the problem of wrong way drivers on New York interstate highways

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 67 1 to read as follows: 2

3 67. WRONG WAY DRIVER PROGRAM. 1. WITHIN ONE YEAR OF THE EFFECTIVE S DATE OF THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL, IN CONSULTATION 4 WITH THE 5 NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES, DEVELOP A PROGRAM TO ADDRESS THE PROBLEM OF WRONG WAY DRIVERS ON NEW YORK б INTERSTATE HIGH-7 WAYS. 8

2. SUCH PROGRAM SHALL:

9 INVESTIGATE POSSIBLE REASONS FOR THE PROBLEM OF WRONG WAY DRIVERS Α. 10 ON NEW YORK INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS;

B. ASSESS WHAT OTHER STATES HAVE DONE TO ADDRESS THIS PROBLEM; 11

C. SET FORTH POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS TO THE PROBLEM; AND

13 D. IMPLEMENT MEASURES TO REDUCE THE PROBLEM OF WRONG WAY DRIVERS ON NEW YORK INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS. 14

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 15
