AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to payments to rural hospitals designated as critical access hospitals

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 2-a of section 2807 of the public health law is 1 amended by adding a new paragraph (j) to read as follows:

3 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SUBDIVISION OR ANY 4 OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY AND, SUBJECT TO AN APPROPRIATION 5 ON AND AFTER APRIL FIRST, TWO THOUSAND SEVENTEEN, RATES OF 6 PAYMENT FOR DIAGNOSTIC AND TREATMENT CENTER SERVICES, EMERGENCY SERVICES, GENERAL HOSPITAL OUTPATIENT 7 SERVICES, AMBULATORY SURGICAL SERVICES AND REFERRED AMBULATORY SERVICES, PROVIDED BY A RURAL 9 AS A CRITICAL ACCESS HOSPITAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE XVIII 10 OF THE FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY ACT SHALL BE EOUAL TO ONE HUNDRED PERCENT OF THE REASONABLE COSTS OF A FACILITY IN PROVIDING SUCH SERVICES 11 PATIENTS ELIGIBLE FOR PAYMENTS MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBDIVI-12 13 SION. REASONABLE COSTS SHALL BE DETERMINED IN A MANNER CONSISTENT USED TO DETERMINE PAYMENT FOR OUTPATIENT CRITICAL ACCESS HOSPITAL 14 15 SERVICES PROVIDED TO BENEFICIARIES OF TITLE XVIII OF THE FEDERAL SOCIAL WITHOUT ADEOUATE COST EXPERIENCE, SUCH 16 SECURITY ACT. FOR FACILITIES RATES SHALL BE BASED ON BUDGETED COSTS 17 SUBSEQUENTLY ADJUSTED TOHUNDRED ONE PERCENT OF REASONABLE ACTUAL COSTS. 18

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This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that 19 20 the implementation of the provisions of this act shall be subject to the appropriation of moneys specifically for the purposes thereof. 21
