AN ACT to amend the workers' compensation law, in relation to livery driver benefit fund

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 18-c of the workers' compensation law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 9 to read as follows:
- INDEPENDENT LIVERY DRIVER WHO SUBMITS A CLAIM FOR RECOVERY IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE FIFTY-ONE OF $_{
 m THE}$ INSURANCE LAW PURSUANT EIGHT OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO LOCAL TAXI AND SUBDIVISION LIMOUSINE COMMISSION RULES PROHIBITING DRIVING UNTIL $_{
 m HE}$ OR SHE HAS 7 RECOVERED FROM HIS OR HER INJURY. ANY AUTHORIZED INSURER REQUIRED TO ACCEPT SUCH CLAIMS SHALL BE ENTITLED TO APPLY THE PRE-AUTHORIZED 8 9 MEDICAL TREATMENT GUIDELINES AND OTHER APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF 10 THIS ARTICLE.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
