AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Marine Captain Eric A. Jones Memorial Highway"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-d to 2 read as follows:
  - 344-D. PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE "MARINE CAPTAIN ERIC A. JONES MEMORIAL HIGHWAY". ALL THAT PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM CONSTITUTING STATE ROUTE ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN POUND RIDGE, COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, BEGINNING AT THE TOWN OF INTERSECTION OF STATE ROUTE ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN AND AVENUE, CONTINUING IN A GENERALLY SOUTHERLY DIRECTION ON STATE ROUTE ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN, AND TERMINATING AT THE NEW YORK AND CONNECTICUT STATE BOUNDARY, SHALL BE DESIGNATED AND KNOWN AS THE "MARINE CAPTAIN ERIC A. JONES MEMORIAL HIGHWAY".
  - S 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be of ceremonial nature and the official name of such shall not be changed as a result of this act.
