AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to mandatory health insurance coverage for prosthetic devices

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph 32 to read as follows:

(32) EVERY POLICY WHICH PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL, OR SIMILAR COMPREHENSIVE TYPE COVERAGE SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR PROSTHETIC 5 DEVICES THAT ARE INTENDED FOR MEDICALLY NECESSARY REHABILITATIVE AND HABILITATIVE PURPOSES AS REQUIRED BY 42 U.S.C. S 18022. COVERAGE SHALL 7 NOT BE DENIED IF THE POLICY HOLDER'S PHYSICIAN DETERMINES THE PROSTHETIC 8 DEVICE ADEQUATELY MEETS THE MEDICAL NEEDS OF POLICY THE HOLDER 9 COMPLIANCE WITH THE AGE, DISABILITY AND EXPECTED LENGTH OF ANTI-DISCRIMINATION REQUIREMENTS OF 42 U.S.C. S 18022 (B)(4)(B) AND THE 10 REQUIREMENT TO CONSIDER THE HEALTH CARE NEEDS OF DIVERSE SEGMENTS OF THE 11 POPULATION, INCLUDING PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES, PURSUANT TO 42 U.S.C. S 12 18022 (B)(4)(C). THE TERM "PROSTHETIC DEVICE" AS USED IN THIS PARAGRAPH 13 LIMB BUT SHALL NOT INCLUDE SHOES OR ANY OTHER 14 INCLUDES AN ARTIFICIAL ARTICLE CONSIDERED AS ORDINARY WEARING APPAREL, WHETHER OR NOT SPECIALLY 15 CONSTRUCTED. SUCH COVERAGE SHALL BE SUBJECT TO ANNUAL DEDUCTIBLES 16 17 COINSURANCE AS DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE SUPERINTENDENT. THE COVERAGE REQUIRED BY THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE IDENTICAL TO, AND SHALL NOT 18 19 INCREASE THE COVERAGE REQUIRED AS PART OF ESSENTIAL HEALTH BENEFITS 20 AS REOUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION 2707(A) OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT 42 U.S.C. S 300 GG-6(A). THE TERM "POLICY HOLDER" AS USED IN THIS 21 PARAGRAPH SHALL MEAN A VETERAN OF THE ARMED FORCES WHO RESIDES 22 IN23 NEW YORK AND WHOSE MEDICAL NEED FOR SUCH PROSTHETIC DEVICE STATE OF RESULTED FROM AN INJURY SUFFERED IN THE LINE OF DUTY 24 WHILE SERVING IN

S 2. Subsection (1) of section 3221 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new paragraph 19 to read as follows:

3 EVERY POLICY WHICH PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL, OR SIMILAR COMPREHENSIVE TYPE COVERAGE SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR PROSTHETIC DEVICES THAT ARE INTENDED FOR MEDICALLY NECESSARY REHABILITATIVE AND HABILITATIVE PURPOSES AS REQUIRED BY 42 U.S.C. S 18022. COVERAGE 7 NOT BE DENIED IF THE POLICY HOLDER'S PHYSICIAN DETERMINES THE PROSTHETIC DEVICE ADEQUATELY MEETS THE MEDICAL NEEDS OF THE POLICY HOLDER IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE AGE, DISABILITY AND EXPECTED LENGTH OF LIFE ANTI-DISCRIMINATION REQUIREMENTS OF 42 U.S.C. S 18022 (B)(4)(B) AND THE 9 10 REQUIREMENT TO CONSIDER THE HEALTH CARE NEEDS OF DIVERSE SEGMENTS OF THE POPULATION, INCLUDING PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES, PURSUANT TO 42 U.S.C. S 12 18022 (B)(4)(C). THE TERM "PROSTHETIC DEVICE" AS USED IN THIS PARAGRAPH 13 14 INCLUDES AN ARTIFICIAL LIMB BUT SHALL NOT INCLUDE SHOES OR ANY OTHER ARTICLE CONSIDERED AS ORDINARY WEARING APPAREL, WHETHER OR NOT SPECIALLY CONSTRUCTED. SUCH COVERAGE SHALL BE SUBJECT TO ANNUAL DEDUCTIBLES AND 16 COINSURANCE AS DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE SUPERINTENDENT. THE COVERAGE 17 REQUIRED BY THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE IDENTICAL TO, AND SHALL NOT ENHANCE 18 19 OR INCREASE THE COVERAGE REQUIRED AS PART OF ESSENTIAL HEALTH BENEFITS REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION 2707(A) OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES 20 21 ACT 42 U.S.C. S 300 GG-6(A). THE TERM "POLICY HOLDER" AS USED PARAGRAPH SHALL MEAN A VETERAN OF THE ARMED FORCES WHO RESIDES IN THE STATE OF NEW YORK AND WHOSE MEDICAL NEED FOR SUCH PROSTHETIC DEVICE 23 RESULTED FROM AN INJURY SUFFERED IN THE LINE OF DUTY WHILE SERVING IN 24 25 THE ARMED FORCES.

S 3. Section 4303 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new subsection (pp) to read as follows:

27 EVERY POLICY WHICH PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL, OR SIMILAR 28 29 COMPREHENSIVE TYPE COVERAGE SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR PROSTHETIC DEVICES THAT ARE INTENDED FOR MEDICALLY NECESSARY REHABILITATIVE AND 30 HABILITATIVE PURPOSES AS REQUIRED BY 42 U.S.C. S 18022. COVERAGE SHALL 31 NOT BE DENIED IF THE POLICY HOLDER'S PHYSICIAN DETERMINES THE PROSTHETIC 32 DEVICE ADEQUATELY MEETS THE MEDICAL NEEDS OF THE POLICY HOLDER IN 33 WITH THE AGE, DISABILITY AND EXPECTED LENGTH OF LIFE 34 COMPLIANCE ANTI-DISCRIMINATION REQUIREMENTS OF 42 U.S.C. S 18022 (B)(4)(B) AND THE 35 REQUIREMENT TO CONSIDER THE HEALTH CARE NEEDS OF DIVERSE SEGMENTS OF THE 36 POPULATION, INCLUDING PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES, PURSUANT TO 42 U.S.C. S 37 18022 (B)(4)(C). THE TERM "PROSTHETIC DEVICE" AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION INCLUDES AN ARTIFICIAL LIMB BUT SHALL NOT INCLUDE SHOES OR 38 39 40 ANY OTHER ARTICLE CONSIDERED AS ORDINARY WEARING APPAREL, WHETHER OR NOT SPECIALLY CONSTRUCTED. SUCH COVERAGE SHALL BE SUBJECT TO ANNUAL DEDUCT-41 IBLES AND COINSURANCE AS DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE SUPERINTENDENT. 42 43 COVERAGE REQUIRED BY THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE IDENTICAL TO, AND SHALL NOT ENHANCE OR INCREASE THE COVERAGE REQUIRED AS PART OF ESSENTIAL HEALTH 44 45 BENEFITS AS REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION 2707(A) OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES ACT 42 U.S.C. S 300 GG-6(A). THE TERM "POLICY HOLDER" AS USED 47 IN THIS SUBSECTION SHALL MEAN A VETERAN OF THE ARMED FORCES WHO RESIDES STATE OF NEW YORK AND WHOSE MEDICAL NEED FOR SUCH PROSTHETIC 48 49 DEVICE RESULTED FROM AN INJURY SUFFERED IN THE LINE OF DUTY WHILE SERV-50 ING IN THE ARMED FORCES.

51 S 4. This act shall take effect May 1, 2016 and shall apply to all 52 policies and contracts issued, renewed, altered, or amended on or after 53 such effective date.
