Introduced by M. of A. RAMOS -- read once and referred to the Committee on Governmental Operations

AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to requiring the superintendent of the state police to establish uniform investigatory standards when there is a shooting of a civilian by a police officer

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 223-a  
2 to read as follows:

3 S 223-A. MINIMUM UNIFORM INVESTIGATORY STANDARDS. THE SUPERINTENDENT  
4 OF THE STATE POLICE SHALL PROMULGATE MINIMUM UNIFORM INVESTIGATORY STAN-  
5 DARDS TO BE IMPLEMENTED WHEN THERE IS A SHOOTING OF A CIVILIAN BY A  
6 POLICE OFFICER AND SHALL MANDATE THAT SUCH STANDARDS MUST BE FOLLOWED  
7 EVERY TIME THERE IS A SHOOTING OF A CIVILIAN BY A POLICE OFFICER.

8 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
