AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to making gas and electric billing information for residential rental premises available upon request

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The public service law is amended by adding a new section 66-o to read as follows:

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S 66-O. GAS AND ELECTRIC BILLING INFORMATION FOR RESIDENTIAL EVERY GAS CORPORATION, ELECTRIC CORPORATION AND MUNICIPALITY SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE TO ANY LANDLORD OR LESSOR OF RESIDENTIAL PREMISES, WITHIN TEN DAYS OF RECEIPT OF A WRITTEN REQUEST THEREFOR FROM ANY PROSPECTIVE TENANT OR LESSEE THEREOF, PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT EXECUTION OF A LEASE, INFORMATION CONSISTING OF THE CHARGES INCURRED AT SUCH PREMISES FOR GAS OR ELECTRIC SERVICE OR BOTH LIFE OF THE DWELLING UNIT OR THE PRECEDING TWO YEAR PERIOD, WHICHEVER IS SUCH INFORMATION SHALL BE IDENTIFIED SOLELY BY THE ADDRESS OF SHORTER. THE DWELLING UNIT, AND NO OTHER INFORMATION IDENTIFYING LESSEE, OR OTHER OCCUPANT OF THE DWELLING UNIT SHALL BE UTILIZED FOR, OR MADE AVAILABLE IN CONNECTION WITH, THE FURNISHING OF BILLING INFORMATION THIS SECTION. SUCH INFORMATION SHALL BE FURNISHED TO BOTH PURSUANT TO THE LANDLORD OR LESSOR AND TO THE PROSPECTIVE TENANT OR LESSEE THE IMPOSITION OF ANY CHARGE OR FEE THEREFOR BY ANY PARTY TO ANY PARTY.

S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after it shall have become a law; provided that the public service commission is authorized to promulgate any and all rules and regulations and take any other measures necessary to implement this act on its effective date on or before such date.
