amend the tax law, in relation to increasing the amount on which additional taxes are imposed for conveyances of real property

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision (a) of section 1402-a of the tax law, as added 2 by chapter 61 of the laws of 1989, is amended to read as follows:

(a) In addition to the tax imposed by section fourteen hundred two of this article, a tax is hereby imposed on each conveyance of residential 5 real property or interest therein when the consideration for the entire conveyance is one million dollars (ADJUSTED FOR INFLATION) or more. For purposes of this section, residential real property shall include any 7 premises that is or may be used in whole or in part as a personal resi-9 dence, and shall include a one, two, or three-family house, an individual condominium unit, or a cooperative apartment unit. The rate of 10 11 shall be one percent of the consideration or part thereof attributable to the residential real property. Such tax shall be paid at 12 same time and in the same manner as the tax imposed by section fourteen 13 14 hundred two of this article. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, MILLION DOLLAR AMOUNT SHALL BE ADJUSTED FOR INFLATION IN EACH CALENDAR 15 YEAR BY MULTIPLYING THE AMOUNT BY THE RATIO OF (I) THE 16 AVERAGE MONTHLY VALUE OF THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX FOR THE TWELVE MONTH PERIOD ENDING ON 17 JUNE THIRTIETH OF THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING CALENDAR 18 YEAR DIVIDED 19 AVERAGE MONTHLY VALUE OF THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX FOR THE 20 TWELVE MONTH PERIOD ENDING ON JUNE THIRTIETH OF THE YEAR IN WHICH 21 SUBDIVISION BECAME A LAW, AND ROUNDING THE AMOUNT TO THE NEAREST THOU-22 SAND DOLLARS. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX MEANS THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (FOR ALL URBAN CONSUMERS, U.S. CITY AVER-
