AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to designating Little Wolf pond and Simon pond as inland waterways for purposes of waterfront revitalization

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 911 of the executive law, as amended by chapter 133 of the laws of 2012, paragraph (a) as separately amended by chapters 92 and 97 of the laws of 2015, paragraph (b) as separately amended by chapters 95, 96 and 97 of the laws of 2015, paragraph (c) as amended by chapter 98 of the laws of 2015, is amended to read as follows:

7 "Inland waterways" shall mean (a) the state's major inland lakes 8 consisting of lakes Ballston, Big Tupper, Black, Campfire, Canadarago, Canandaigua, Cayuga, Champlain, Chateaugay, Chautauqua, Conesus, Cran-9 berry, Echo (in the county of Westchester), George, Great Sacandaga, 10 Indian, Keuka, Long, Mirror, Oneida, Onondaga, Otisco, Otsego, 11 Honeoye, 12 Owasco, Peach, Placid, Raquette, Ronkonkoma, Sacandaga, 13 Seneca, Skaneateles, Silver (in the county of Wyoming) and Schroon, Saranac, and the Fulton chain of lakes; (b) the state's major rivers 14 15 comprised of the Allegheny, Ausable, Battenkill, Black, Boquet, Bronx, 16 Canisteo, Chaumont (including Chaumont bay), Chemung, Cohocton, 17 ware, Deer, Genesee, Grasse, Great Chazy, Hoosic, Hudson north of the 18 federal dam at Troy, Indian, Little (in the Adirondack park), Little 19 Little Salmon (including north and south branches), Mad, Mettowee, Mohawk, Oswegatchie, Pocantico, Racquette, Sacandaga, 20 Saw Mill, Schroon, Susquehanna, Tioga, Tioughnioga, Wallkill 21 22 and Buffalo rivers, and the north and middle branches of the Moose 23 river; (c) the state's major creeks comprised of the 18 Mile Creek
