AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to the inclusion of business interruption insurance in all commercial insurance policies

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 3420 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new paragraph 7 to read as follows:
- (7) A PROVISION IN ALL COMMERCIAL INSURANCE POLICIES PROVIDING COVER-AGE AGAINST THE LOSS OF PERISHABLE PROPERTY DUE TO A BLACK-OUT OR POWER OUTAGE THAT LASTS TWELVE HOURS OR LONGER.
- 6 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to all policies issued, renewed, or altered on or after such effective date.
