## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY

proposing an amendment to section 2 of article 3 of the constitution, in relation to increasing the terms of office of members of the ture to four years

Section 1. Resolved (if the Senate concur), That section 2 of article 3 of the constitution be amended to read as follows:

- S 2. The senate shall consist of fifty members, except as hereinafter provided. The senators [elected in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five shall hold their offices three years, for and successors] shall be [chosen] ELECTED for TERMS OF two years; PROVIDED, 7 THAT SENATORS ELECTED IN THE YEAR TWO THOUSAND SEVENTEEN AND IN 8 THEREAFTER SHALL HOLD THEIR OFFICES OUENT YEARS FOR FOUR YEARS; 9 PROVIDED, FURTHER, THAT IN ALL LEGISLATIVE TERMS THAT COMMENCE DIATELY FOLLOWING A DECENNIAL CENSUS YEAR, THE TERM SHALL BE TWO YEARS. 10 The assembly shall consist of one hundred and fifty members. The assem-11 12 members [elected in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty-13 eight, and their successors, ] shall be [chosen] ELECTED for TERMS OF two years; PROVIDED, THAT ASSEMBLY MEMBERS ELECTED IN THE YEAR TWO 14 THOUSAND SEVENTEEN AND IN SUBSEQUENT YEARS THEREAFTER SHALL HOLD THEIR OFFICES 15 FOR FOUR YEARS; PROVIDED, FURTHER, THAT IN ALL LEGISLATIVE 16 TERMS 17 COMMENCE IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING A DECENNIAL CENSUS YEAR, THE TERM SHALL 18 BE TWO YEARS.
  - S 2. Resolved (if the Senate concur), That the provisions of the foregoing amendments shall apply only to terms of office commencing after such amendments shall have been adopted pursuant to section 1 of article 19 of the constitution.
- 23 S 3. Resolved (if the Senate concur), That the foregoing amendments be 24 referred to the first regular legislative session convening after the 25 next succeeding general election of the members of the assembly, and, in conformity with section 1 of article 19 of the constitution, 26 published for three months previous to the time of such election. 27
