CONCURRENT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY

proposing an amendment to section 2 of article 3 of the constitution, in relation to increasing the terms of office of members of the legislature to four years

Section 1. Resolved (if the Senate concur), That section 2 of article 3 of the constitution be amended to read as follows:

3 S 2. The senate shall consist of fifty members, except as hereinafter provided. The senators [elected in the year one thousand eight hundred 4 5 and ninety-five shall hold their offices for three years, and their б successors] shall be [chosen] ELECTED for TERMS OF two years; PROVIDED, 7 ELECTED IN THE YEAR TWO THOUSAND EIGHTEEN AND IN SUBSE-THAT SENATORS 8 THEREAFTER SHALL HOLD THEIR OFFICES FOR FOUR OUENT YEARS YEARS; 9 IN ALL LEGISLATIVE TERMS THAT COMMENCE IMME-PROVIDED, FURTHER, THAT DIATELY FOLLOWING A DECENNIAL CENSUS YEAR, THE TERM SHALL BE TWO 10 YEARS. The assembly shall consist of one hundred and fifty members. The assem-11 bly members [elected in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty-12 eight, and their successors,] shall be [chosen] ELECTED for TERMS OF two 13 14 years; PROVIDED, THAT ASSEMBLY MEMBERS ELECTED IN THE YEAR TWO THOUSAND EIGHTEEN AND IN SUBSEQUENT YEARS THEREAFTER SHALL HOLD THEIR OFFICES FOR 15 FOUR YEARS; PROVIDED, FURTHER, 16 THAT IN ALL LEGISLATIVE TERMS THAT IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING A DECENNIAL CENSUS YEAR, THE TERM SHALL 17 COMMENCE 18 BE TWO YEARS.

19 S 2. Resolved (if the Senate concur), That the provisions of the fore-20 going amendments shall apply only to terms of office commencing after 21 such amendments shall have been adopted pursuant to section 1 of article 22 19 of the constitution.
