AN ACT authorizing MiYaD Beis Jericho, Inc. to receive retroactive real property tax exempt status

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the assessor of the county of Nassau is hereby authorized to accept from MiYaD Beis Jericho, Inc. an application for exemption for real property taxes pursuant to section 420-a of the real property tax law for part of the 2013-2014 assessment roll and the 2014-2015 assessment roll, for the parcel conveyed to such organization, with such parcel being located in hamlet of Jericho at 82 Forsythia Lane, otherwise known as Nassau county tax map section 12, block 577, lot 35. If accepted, the application shall be reviewed as if it had been received on or before the taxable status date established for such roll.

If satisfied that such organization would otherwise be entitled to such exemption if such organization had filed an application for exemption by the appropriate taxable status date, such assessor, upon by the Nassau county legislature, may make appropriate approval correction to the subject roll. If such exemption is granted the applicable governing body or tax department may, in its sole discretion, provide for the refund of those taxes paid and cancel those taxes, fines, penalties, liens, or interest remaining unpaid.
