AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to prohibiting providers from imposing a fee for termination or early cancellation of certain service contracts in the event a customer has deceased before the end of such contract

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 2 399-zzzz to read as follows:
 - S 399-ZZZZ. PROHIBITION OF CERTAIN FEE CHARGES FOR TERMINATION OR EARLY CANCELLATION. 1. SUBJECT TO FEDERAL LAW AND REGULATION, NO PROVIDER OF TELEPHONE, CELLULAR TELEPHONE, TELEVISION, INTERNET, ENERGY, OR WATER SERVICES SHALL IMPOSE A FEE FOR TERMINATION OR EARLY CANCELLATION OF A SERVICE CONTRACT IN THE EVENT THE CUSTOMER HAS DECEASED BEFORE THE END OF SUCH CONTRACT.
- 9 2. EVERY VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE PUNISHABLE BY A CIVIL 10 PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
