AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to
enacting the "New York beverage modernization act"; and to repeal
certain provisions of such law relating thereto

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "New York
2 beverage modernization act".
3 S 2. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 14 of section 105 of the alcoholic
4 beverage control law, as amended by section 1 of part U of chapter 63 of
5 the laws of 2003, is amended to read as follows:
6 (a) No premises licensed to sell liquor and/or wine for off-premises
7 consumption shall be permitted to remain open[:
8 (i) On Sunday before twelve o'clock post meridian and after nine
9 o'clock post meridian.
10 (ii) On] ON any day between midnight and eight o'clock antemeridian.
11 [(iii) On the twenty-fifth day of December, known as Christmas day.]
12 In any community where daylight saving time is in effect, such time
13 shall be deemed the standard time for the purpose of this subdivision.
14 S 3. Section 105-a of the alcoholic beverage control law is REPEALED.
15 S 4. Subdivision 5 of section 106 of the alcoholic beverage control
16 law, as amended by chapter 83 of the laws of 1995, is amended to read as
17 follows:
18 5. No alcoholic beverages shall be sold, offered for sale or given
19 away upon any premises licensed to sell alcoholic beverages at retail
20 for on-premises consumption[, during the following hours:
21 (a) Sunday, from four ante meridiem to twelve noon.
22 (b) On] ON any [other] day between four ante meridiem and eight ante
23 meridiem.
24 Unless otherwise approved by the authority pursuant to subdivision
25 [eleven] NINE of section seventeen of this chapter, where any rule has
26 been adopted in a county on or before April first, nineteen hundred
27 ninety-five, further restricting the hours of sale for alcoholic bever-

1 ages, such restricted hours shall be the hours, during which the sale of
2 alcoholic beverages at retail for on-premises consumption shall not be
3 permitted within such county.

4 Nor shall any person be permitted to consume any alcoholic beverages
5 upon any such premises later than one-half hour after the start of the
6 prohibited hours of sale provided for in this section.

7 S 5. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
8 have become a law.
