AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to requiring the department of health to provide information on neonatal abstinence syndrome screening, intervention, and counseling for pregnant women on a department website devoted to advancing women's health initiatives

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Paragraphs (u) and (v) of subdivision 1 of section 266 of 2 the public health law, as added by chapter 342 of the laws of 2014, are 3 amended and a new paragraph (w) is added to read as follows:
 - (u) Syphilis screening for all pregnant women or other women at increased risk; [and]
 - (v) Well-woman visits to obtain recommended preventive services; AND
 - (W) NEONATAL ABSTINENCE SYNDROME SCREENING, INTERVENTIONS AND COUNSELING FOR PREGNANT WOMEN.
 - S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
