

1 4. A STUDENT WHO APPLIES PURSUANT TO THE AUTOMATIC APPLICATION PROGRAM
2 AND MEETS THE STANDARDS PROMULGATED BY THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK
3 AND THE CITY UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS
4 SECTION SHALL BE ACCEPTED FOR ADMISSION INTO SUCH UNIVERSITIES.

5 5. STUDENT DATA SHALL BE DELETED NO LATER THAN TWO YEARS AFTER THE
6 CREATION OF SUCH STUDENT'S ONLINE ACCOUNT.

7 S 192. DATA PUBLICATION. THE OFFICE OF HIGHER EDUCATION, IN CONJUNC-
8 TION WITH THE BOARD OF REGENTS, SHALL COLLECT AND PUBLISH AN ANNUAL
9 REPORT OF STUDENTS ADMITTED THROUGH THE AUTOMATIC APPLICATION PROGRAM.
10 THE REPORT SHALL INCLUDE DATA OF ACCEPTED STUDENTS DISAGGREGATED BY
11 RACE, ETHNICITY, SOCIOECONOMIC STATUS, GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION, AND HIGH
12 SCHOOL INSTITUTION.

13 S 193. PROGRAM PROMOTION. THE OFFICE OF HIGHER EDUCATION, IN CONJUNC-
14 TION WITH THE BOARD OF REGENTS, SHALL CREATE AND IMPLEMENT A PROGRAM TO
15 INFORM HIGH SCHOOLS AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC ABOUT THE AUTOMATIC APPLICA-
16 TION PROGRAM.

17 S 194. RULEMAKING AUTHORITY. THE BOARD OF REGENTS SHALL PROMULGATE
18 SUCH REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSIONER AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT
19 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE.

20 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of August next succeeding
21 the date on which it shall have become a law.
