THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 84 to read as follows:

3 84. EMPLOYEES OF THE JACOB K. JAVITS CONVENTION CENTER PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT WORKING AS PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS, SUPERVISORS OR MANAGERS; 4 PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT NOTHING IN THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE DEEMED TO 5 AUTHORIZE SUCH OFFICER TO CARRY, POSSESS, REPAIR OR DISPOSE OF A FIREARM 6 7 UNLESS THE APPROPRIATE LICENSE THEREFOR HAS BEEN ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 400.00 OF THE PENAL LAW. 8

9 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
