AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to the distribution of fire insurance premium taxes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph 1 of subsection (d) of section 9105 of the insurlaw, as amended by chapter 293 of the laws of 1988, is amended to read as follows:

(1) The amount of all monies which were received by the superintendent on or before the first day of April in each year under the provisions of this section or section nine thousand one hundred four of this article shall be distributed by him OR HER not later than the first day of July in such year, after adding any earnings resulting from the investment of such monies and deducting the expenses of collection and distribution. NINE percent of such remaining monies received under this section shall be paid to the treasurer of the Firemen's Association of the State of New York for the support and maintenance of the firemen's home at AND ONE PERCENT OF SUCH REMAINING MONIES RECEIVED Hudson, New York, UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE PAID TO THE TREASURER OF THE NEW YORK FIREFIGHTERS ASSOCIATION TO PROMOTE, SUPPORT AND MAINTAIN PROFESSIONAL THE WELL-BEING OF PAID PROFESSIONAL FIREFIGHTERS EMPLOYED IN THE OF NEW YORK, and the balance shall be paid as specified in paragraph two 17 [hereof] OF THIS SUBSECTION, in amounts which will be that proportion of 19 the balance so to be distributed which the total amount of fire insurance business written by foreign mutual fire insurance companies on property situated in such locality bears to the total amount of fire 22 insurance business written by foreign mutual fire insurance companies on property situated in any and all of the protected localities in the 23 state having treasurers or other fiscal officers as designated in para-24 25 graph two [hereof] OF THIS SUBSECTION afforded fire protection by a fire department or fire company and upon which the tax provided 27 section has been paid.
