AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, the domestic relations law and the judiciary law, in relation to translation services for certain orders by courts of competent jurisdiction

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 530.12 of the criminal procedure law is amended by adding a new subdivision 16 to read as follows:

- 16. THE COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION SHALL PROVIDE TRANSLATION SERVICES OF AN ORDER OF PROTECTION OR TEMPORARY ORDER OF PROTECTION, AS PROVIDED BY PARAGRAPH (U) OF SUBDIVISION TWO OF SECTION TWO HUNDRED TWELVE OF THE JUDICIARY LAW, TO ANY DEFENDANT AND/OR PERSON PROTECTED BY SUCH ORDER OF PROTECTION WHO IS NOT FLUENT IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE. SUCH TRANSLATION, OR THE INABILITY TO TRANSLATE INTO A DEFENDANT'S NATIVE LANGUAGE, SHALL NOT AFFECT THE VALIDITY OR ENFORCEABILITY OF THE ORDER.

THE COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION SHALL PROVIDE TRANSLATION SERVICES OF AN ORDER OF PROTECTION OR TEMPORARY ORDER OF PROTECTION, AS PROVIDED BY PARAGRAPH (U) OF SUBDIVISION TWO OF SECTION TWO HUNDRED TWELVE OF THE JUDICIARY LAW, TO ANY DEFENDANT AND/OR PERSON PROTECTED BY SUCH ORDER OF PROTECTION WHO IS NOT FLUENT IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE. 1 NATIVE LANGUAGE, SHALL NOT AFFECT THE VALIDITY OR ENFORCEABILITY OF THE 2 ORDER.

- S 4. Section 252 of the domestic relations law is amended by adding a new subdivision 1-a to read as follows:
- 1-A. THE COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION SHALL PROVIDE TRANSLATION SERVICES OF AN ORDER OF PROTECTION OR TEMPORARY ORDER OF PROTECTION, AS PROVIDED BY PARAGRAPH (U) OF SUBDIVISION TWO OF SECTION TWO HUNDRED TWELVE OF THE JUDICIARY LAW, TO ANY RESPONDENT AND/OR PERSON PROTECTED BY SUCH ORDER OF PROTECTION WHO IS NOT FLUENT IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE. SUCH TRANSLATION, OR THE INABILITY TO TRANSLATE INTO A RESPONDENT'S NATIVE LANGUAGE, SHALL NOT AFFECT THE VALIDITY OR ENFORCEABILITY OF THE ORDER.
- 13 S 5. Subdivision 2 of section 212 of the judiciary law is amended by 14 adding a new paragraph (u) to read as follows:
 - (U) (I) PROVIDE TRANSLATION SERVICES TO ALL COURTS TO ASSIST IN THE TRANSLATION OF ALL ORDERS OF PROTECTION OR TEMPORARY ORDERS OF PROTECTION WHERE THE PETITIONER OR RESPONDENT, OR VICTIM OR DEFENDANT, IS NOT FLUENT IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE.
 - (II) SUCH TRANSLATION SERVICES SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO ALL FAMILY COURTS AND CRIMINAL COURTS THAT ISSUE ORDERS OF PROTECTION OR TEMPORARY ORDERS OF PROTECTION, AND SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE IN THE TEN MOST FREQUENTLY USED LANGUAGES IN NEW YORK STATE, AS WELL AS ANY ADDITIONAL LANGUAGES THAT THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATOR OF THE COURTS DEEMS APPROPRIATE.
 - (III) TRANSLATION SERVICES MAY BE PROVIDED THROUGH THE USE OF COMPUTER SOFTWARE, BUT MUST ALSO BE AVAILABLE THROUGH AUDIO MEANS FOR THE VISUALLY IMPAIRED.
- 27 (IV) TRANSLATION SERVICES SHALL NOT AFFECT THE VALIDITY OR ENFORCEA-28 BILITY OF ANY ORDER.
 - S 6. The chief administrator of the courts may promulgate rules and regulations in order to effectuate the provisions of this act.
- 31 S 7. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 32 have become a law and shall apply to orders of protection issued on or 33 after such effective date.
