AN ACT to amend the civil practice law and rules, in relation to the authenticating effect of a party's production of material authored or otherwise created by the party

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The civil practice law and rules is amended by adding a new 2 rule 4540-a to read as follows:
- RULE 4540-A. PRESUMPTION OF AUTHENTICITY BASED ON A PARTY'S PRODUCTION OF MATERIAL AUTHORED OR OTHERWISE CREATED BY THE PARTY. MATERIAL 5 PRODUCED BY A PARTY IN RESPONSE TO A DEMAND PURSUANT TO ARTICLE THIRTY-ONE OF THIS CHAPTER FOR MATERIAL AUTHORED OR OTHERWISE CREATED 7 SHALL BE PRESUMED AUTHENTIC WHEN OFFERED INTO EVIDENCE BY AN PARTY 8 ADVERSE PARTY. SUCH PRESUMPTION MAY BE REBUTTED BY A PREPONDERANCE 9 EVIDENCE PROVING SUCH MATERIAL IS NOT AUTHENTIC, AND SHALL NOT PRECLUDE
- 10 ANY OTHER OBJECTION TO ADMISSIBILITY.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-12 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
